- brown .01 Pigma pen, trace your pattern onto the fabric Center your pattern under the fabric & pin the fabric to Begin by pressing your 18"x 20" stitchery fabric well. as follows. the pattern in several places. Using a light box and a

X's placement Lazy daisy leaves should be traced only as small dots at the bottom or "pointed" end of the stitch. French knots buttonhole or fly as the traced lines will be very hard to Do not trace the specialty stitches such as feather, French knots

Either "eyeball" it's placement or use basting thread to make a line down it's center to follow of the buttonhole stitch but the feather stitch should not stitch and a straight line along the un-interrupted edge You can trace a straight line down the center of the fly
 - Dry press your stitchery fabric after tracing and also press your pre-washed plain white muslin backing. Layer the two and press again.
