Cut 4-3/8" $\times 18^{\prime \prime}$ of ANTE 419Zfor stems
Cut $4-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 9$ " of ANTE 419Zfor stems

## Borders:

Cut 6-6"x42" of ANTE 421EZ for first border
Cut 16-3.25 Squares of ANIE 421EZfor border comerstone Blocks

Cut 4-6" Squares of ANIE 417N for border comerstone blocks

Cut 4-4"x62"ANTE 415B
(This is cut the lengthwise way)

## PIECED BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

Each block will consist of:
4-1.5" small print squares
$1-3.5^{\prime \prime}$ small print square
4-1.5" $\times 3.5$ " background rectangles

1. Join four 1.5 " squares to two 1.5 " $\times 3.5$ " rectangles. Press toward squares.
2. Sew two $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5$ " rectangles to one 3.5 " square, as shown. Press to ward Square.
3. J oin the three rows. Block should measure 5.5" square. Make 42.


## QUILTCENTER CONSTRUCTION

Since this quilt has blocks set on point, you must sew the rows diagonally as shown below. The first row has only the comer triangle, the second has two setting triangles and a pieced block and so on. There is a total of fourteen diagonal rows. See diagram on last page.

Press following the a rrows.


1. Draw a diagonal line on the BACK of all 16 of the 3.25 " ANTE 421 EZsquares.
2. Place one 3.25 " square on the top right hand comer of a 6" ANIE 417 N , right sides together as shown.
3. Sew on drawn line.
4. Cut $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from sewn line as shown,
5. Pesstoward outercomer.
6. Repeat on opposite comer, then both remaining comers.

Notice that you have a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance on all four sides.

Make four.


## BORDER APPUQUE

You may use any technique you wish to finish the a pplique. The templates given DO NOT include a seam allowance fortumed edge applique.

1. Measure for the length of the first border. The long side should be approximately 49.5" and the short side about 42.5. Cut and piece these pieces to your measurements from the 6" ANTE 421EZpieces.
2. By folding the 6 " border pieces in half, both ways to create a center point, you have a way to keep the a pplique centered.

3. Lay out the applique as shown. Notice that half the leaves at the center of each spray are tipped a way from the stem at a greater angle.


The final construction is shown below. Follow the pressing a rrows.
For the outer border, be sure to attach the side borders first, pressing to the outside.
