### **Fabric Needed:**

Blocks/Flowers: 1 Layer Cake

or 40 - 10" squares

Leaves: 1/4 yard First Border: 2/3 yard 1 1/4 yards Outside Border: Large Rick Rack: 7 yards

Notions: 10 - 2" buttons

**Fusible Web:** 1/4 yard Back: 3 5/8 yards Binding: 5/8 yard 64" x 72" Batting:

## **Cutting Instructions:**

Strips are cut from selvage to selvage

1. Flowers

Choose 10 - 10" squares for flowers. Set aside.

- 2. Blocks
  - a. Choose 10 10" squares to remain whole (A). Set these aside.
  - b. Cut 20 5" x 10" pieces (B) as shown in diagram.
  - c. Cut 10 7 1/2" x 10" pieces (C) and 10 2 1/2" x 10" pieces (D) as shown in diagram.
- 3. First Border


Cut 6 - 2 1/2" strips.

4. Outside Border

Cut 6 - 5" strips.

# **Sewing Instructions:**

- 1. Columns
  - a. Lay out A, B & C pieces in order: C / B / A / B / C / B / A / B. Stitch together to make column 1. Repeat to make 3.
  - b. Lay out A, B & C pieces in order: B / A / B / A / C / B / B / C. Stitch together to make column 2. Repeat to make 2.

- c. Stitch columns together in alternating order.
- d. Stitch 5 D pieces together end to end.

Repeat to make 2.

Stitch to top and bottom of columns.

## 2. Flowers

Using template plastic or cardboard, make template of 10" circle.

Mark circles on 10 set aside squares and cut on line.

With needle and thread, make gathering stitch 1/8"

from edge of circle, folding 1/4" to back of fabric as you go.

After stitching all the way around circle, pull thread to gather and form yo yo.

Tie knot to secure gathering stitch.

\*Note: You can insert 5" circle of plastic, batting, fleece etc.

to make stiffer if desired.

Repeat to make 10.

Lay flowers out as desired on columns. Pin in place.

#### 3. Stems

Measure from bottom of quilt to center of flower.

Cut rick rack measured length.

Repeat for all 10 stems.

Remove flowers until after quilting is finished.

Pin rick rack in place and stitch down.

#### 4. Leaves

Using template plastic or cardboard, make template of leaf.

Mark leaves on paper side of fusible web.

Press leaves on wrong side of fabric making sure fabric is larger than fusible web.

Cut out leaves on marked lines.

Remove paper backing.

Position leaves. Press into place.

Finish edges as desired.

We recommend using close finishing stitches because of the raw edge.

\*If your finishing stitches are close together, you can place a piece of white paper underneath your fabric to act as a stabilizer while you stitch.

When finished, rip paper off back.

## 5. First Border - Press to border

Stitch border pieces together end to end.

Cut into segments: 2 - 55 1/2", 2 - 52".

Stitch 55 1/2" pieces to right and left sides.

Stitch 52" pieces to top and bottom.

## 6. Outside Border - Press to border

Stitch border strips together end to end.

Cut into segments: 2 - 61", 2 - 59 1/2".

Stitch 59 1/2" pieces to right and left sides.

Stitch 61" pieces to top and bottom.

### 7. Quilt and bind.

Attach yo yos using 2" buttons as centers after quilting.
