

# ocean breeze 

Make a quilt in light and breezy fabrics that are perfect for a teenager.
The blues and greens are fresh as an ocean breeze.

## MATERIALS

## PROJECT RATING: EASY

Size: 74" x 90"
Blocks: 25 (14") blocks

NOTE: Fabrics in the quilt shown are from the Flights of Fancy collection by Paula Prass for Michael Miller Fabrics.
$11 / 2$ yards light green print
2 yards aqua print for borders and binding
$11 / 4$ yards green stripe
$31 / 2$ yards large dot print
NOTE: If not fussy cutting,
2 yards are required.
$1 / 2$ yard each of 5 assorted
light green and aqua stripes
and prints
$51 / 2$ yards backing fabric
Full-size quilt batting

## Cutting

Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. Border strips are exact length needed. You may want to make them longer to allow for piecing variations.

## From light green print, cut:

- 4 ( $10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide) strips. From strips, cut 52 ( $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ " $\times 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) D rectangles.


## From aqua print, cut:

- 1 ( $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " -wide) strip. From strip, cut 2 ( $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) G rectangles, 4 ( $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ") F rectangles, and 4 ( $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) E rectangles.
- 13 ( $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide) strips. Piece strips to make $4\left(2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 701 / 22^{\prime \prime}\right)$ top and
bottom borders and 2
( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $901 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) side borders.
- 9 ( $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " -wide) strips for binding.


## From green stripe, cut:

- $9\left(2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$-wide) strips. From strips, cut 52 ( $\left.21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ C rectangles.
- 1 ( $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide) strip. From strip, cut 2 ( $14^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 ⁄ 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) G rectangles, 4 ( $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 33^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) F rectangles, and 4 ( $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) E rectangles.


## From large dot print, cut:

- 11 ( $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide) strips, centering dots on each. From strips, cut 104 (2½") B squares.


## From remaining large dot print, cut:

- 3 ( $61 / 2$ "-wide) lengthwise strips, centering dots on each. From strips, cut $2\left(61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 701 / 2\right.$ ") strips for top and bottom borders and 13 ( $61 / 2$ ") A squares, centering dots on each.


## From each assorted print or

 stripe, cut:- 1 ( $141 / 22^{\prime \prime}$-wide) strip. From strips, cut a total of $8\left(14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ G rectangles, 16 ( $\left.14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right) \mathrm{F}$ rectangles, and 16 ( $\left.14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}\right)$ E rectangles.


## Block Assembly

1. Lay out 1 A square, 8 B squares, 4 green stripe C rectangles, and 4 light green print D rectangles as shown in Block 1 Assembly Diagram. Join to complete 1 Block 1 (Block 1 Diagram). Make 13 Block 1.
2. Lay out 2 assorted $E$ rectangles, 2 assorted F rectangles, and 1 G rectangle as shown in Block 2 Assembly Diagram. Join to complete 1 Block 2 (Block 2 Diagram). Make 12 Block 2.

## Quilt Assembly

1. Lay out blocks as shown in Quilt Top Assembly Diagram. Join into rows; join rows to complete quilt center.
2. Join 2 aqua print top and bottom borders and 1 large dot border to make top border. Repeat for bottom border.
3. Add top and bottom borders to quilt center.
4. Add aqua print side borders to quilt.

## Finishing

1. Divide backing into 2 ( $2^{3 / 4}$-yard) lengths. Cut 1 piece in half lengthwise to make 2 narrow panels. Join 1 narrow panel to each side of wider panel; press seam allowances toward narrow panels.
2. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired. Quilt shown was quilted in the ditch and with straight lines between rows of dots in the blocks and border (Quilting Diagram).
3. Join $2^{114}$ "-wide aqua print strips into 1 continuous piece for straightgrain French-fold binding. Add binding to quilt.
