## Citrus

## Precut strips in jelly rolls make this quilt super quick and easy.

## MATERIALS

$1 / 4$ yard each of 8 assorted marble prints in purple, pink, yellow, blue, and green for blocks (or 1 jelly roll)
1 fat quarter* each red and orange marble prints for border
2 yards blue marble print for setting squares and triangles and binding 3 yards backing fabric
$107 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square template plastic
Twin-size quilt batting
*fat quarter $=18^{\prime \prime} \times 20 "$

NOTE: Fabrics in the quilt shown are from Marble Jelly Rolls by Moda Fabrics.

## Cutting

Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. Border strips are exact length needed. You may want to make them longer to allow for piecing variations. Cut $107 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square template plastic in half diagonally to make Triangle template.
From each of 8 marble prints, cut:

- 3 ( $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide) strips for strip sets.

From each fat quarter, cut:

- 6 ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide) strips. Piece strips as shown in Quilt Top Assembly Diagram on page 60 to make 2 ( $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 57^{\prime \prime}$ ) side borders and $2\left(2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 47^{\prime \prime}\right)$ top and bottom borders.
From blue marble print, cut:
- 2 ( $151 / 2$ "-wide) strips. From strips,
cut 3 (15½") squares and 2 (8") squares. Cut $15^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares in half diagonally in both directions to make 12 side setting triangles ( 2 are extra). Cut 8 " squares in half diagonally to make 4 corner setting triangles.
- $2(101 / 2$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut $6\left(101 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ setting squares.
- 6 ( $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " -wide) strips for binding.


## Block Assembly

1. Join 4 assorted marble print strips as shown in Strip Set Diagram. Make 6 strip sets. From each strip set, cut 4 triangles.
2. Join 2 triangles to complete 1 block (Block Diagram). Make 12 blocks.


## Quilt Assembly

1. Lay out blocks and blue marble print setting squares and triangles as shown in Quilt Top Assembly Diagram. Join into diagonal rows; join rows to complete quilt center.
2. Add side borders to quilt center. Add top and bottom borders to quilt.

## Finishing

1. Divide backing into 2 ( $1 \frac{1}{2}$-yard) lengths. Join panels lengthwise. Seam will run horizontally.
2. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired. Quilt shown was quilted with concentric squares in blocks and a star design in blue squares and border (Quilting Diagram).
3. Join $2^{1 ⁄ 4}$ "-wide blue marble print strips into 1 continuous piece for straight-grain French-fold binding. Add binding to quilt.
