This quilt is made of 2 blocks that you can arrange in a variety of ways. This way your quilt can be your very own. I would love to see how you have done it...drop me a line at bluenickel5@earthlink.net so I can see what you have done with it or if you have any questions.

Fabric requirements-(you will have leftovers-incorporate them into the back or make potholders for the grill!!)
Some of these fabrics were fussy cut to get the look shown. You may want to buy extra fabric to accomplish this. Note:--- $1 / 4$ " seams are assumed throughout this pattern.

- 1 fat quarter BA01Gold
- 1 yard BA01Red
- 1 fat quarter BA02Gold
- $5 / 8$ yard BA03Blue
- $5 / 8$ yard BA04Green
- 1 fat quarter BA04Red
- $1 / 2$ yard BA05Gold
- $1 / 2$ yard BA05Red
- $5 / 8$ yard BA06Gold
- 1 fat quarter BA06Grey


## Block 1-Plain Monkey Wrench Block

---Cutting and piecing directions are for ONE block--- make 7 blocks for the quilt using these directions (fabrics for Block 1-A through 1-G are listed at the end of this set of instructions)

1. Cut (2) $4-7 / 8 " \times 4-7 / 8$ " squares, then cut them in half diagonally once to make (4) $\mathbf{1 b}$ pieces.
2. Cut (2) $4-7 / 8$ " $\times 4-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, then cut them in half diagonally once to make (4) 1a pieces.
3. Cut (4) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{1 c}$ pieces.
4. Cut (4) $2-1 / 2 " \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} 1 d$ pieces.
5. Cut (1) $6-1 / 2 "$ x $6-1 / 2 "$ " 1 e piece.

Sew the $\mathbf{1 b}$ and $\mathbf{1 a}$ pieces together, then sew the $\mathbf{1 d}$ and $\mathbf{1 c}$ pieces together. Now sew them together with the 1e piece as shown in the diagram below:


Fabric selections for each Block 1 (A-G):
Block 1-A

- 1a-BA08Gold, 1b-BA01Red, 1c-BA09Gold, 1d- BA08Gold, 1e-BA01Red Block 1-B
- 1a-BA07Blue, 1b-BA06Gold, 1c-BA03Blue, 1d-BA06Gold, 1e-BA05Red Block 1-C
- 1a-BA04Red, 1b-BA05Red, 1c-BA06Grey, 1d-BA07Gold, 1e-BA01Gold Block 1-D
- 1a-BA06Grey, 1b-BA03Blue, 1c-BA01Red, 1 d -BA03Blue, 1e-BA05Gold Block 1-E
- 1a-BA07Gold, 1b-BA05Red, 1c-BA03Blue, 1d-BA07Gold, 1e-BA01Gold Block 1-F
- 1a-BA0Grey, 1b-BA04Green, 1c-BA01Gold, 1d-BA04Green, 1e-BA02Gold Block 1-G
- 1a-BA04Red, 1b-BA08Gold, 1c- BA02Gold, 1d-BA04Red, 1e-BA01Red


## Block 2- Funky Monkey Wrench Block

---cutting and piecing directions are for ONE block--- make 2 blocks (fabrics for Block 2-A and $2-\mathrm{B}$ are listed at the end of this set of instructions)

1. Cut (2) $4-7 / 8 " \times 4-7 / 8 "$ squares, then cut them in half diagonally once to make (4) $\mathbf{2 b}$ pieces.
2. Cut (2) $4-7 / 8 " \times 4-7 / 8 "$ squares, then cut them in half diagonally once to make (4) $\mathbf{2 a}$ pieces.
3. Cut (4) $2-1 / 2 " \times 6-1 / 2 " 2 \mathrm{c}$ pieces.
4. Cut (4) $2-1 / 2 " \times 6-1 / 2 " 2 d$ pieces.
5. Cut (1) $2-1 / 2 "$ x $2-1 / 2 " 2$ e piece.
6. Cut (2) $2-1 / 2 " x \quad 2-1 / 2 " 2 f$ pieces.
7. Cut (2) $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 6-1 / 2 " 2 g$ pieces.

Sew the $\mathbf{2 b}$ and $\mathbf{2 a}$ pieces together, then sew the $\mathbf{2 d}$ and $\mathbf{2 c}$ pieces together. Next, sew the $\mathbf{2 f}$ pieces to the 2 e piece, then sew the $\mathbf{2 g}$ pieces to the sides of that unit as shown. Sew all these units together as shown in the diagram below:

Fabric selections for each Block 2 (A-B):
Block 2-A

- 2a-BA07Blue, 2b-BA04Red, 2c- BA04Red, 2d-BA07Blue, 2e-BA04Red, 2f- BA08 Gold, 2g- BA08Gold


## Block 2-B

- 2a- BA07 Gold, 2b-BA09-Gold, 2c- BA09-Gold, 2d- BA07Gold, 2e-BA08Gold, 2f BA04Red, 2g - BA04Red


## Prepare Sashing for the blocks-

This quilt has a unique sashing setting. There are 8 distinct sashing units and 2 different cornerstones. Cut and piece these units together then work them into the quilt layout below. Refer to the photo for placement as well. Some of these fabrics were fussy cut to get the look shown. You may want to buy extra fabric to accomplish this.

1. Cut (8) $4-1 / 2$ " $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces of BA05Red for Cornerstones C1.
2. Cut (8) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces of BA05Gold for Cornerstones C2.
3. Cut (2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2^{"}$ pieces of BA03Blue for Sash-8
4. Cut (2) $4-1 / 2$ " $\times 14-1 / 2$ " pieces of BA06Gold for Sash-9
5. Cut (2) $4-1 / 2$ " x $14-1 / 2$ " pieces of BA04Green for Sash-10
6. Cut and sew together on the long side (5) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" pieces of BA01Red and (5) 2$1 / 2$ " x 14-1/2" pieces of BA03Blue for Sash-1, Sash-4, Sash-11, Sash-15, and Sash-19.
7. Cut and sew together on the long side (2) $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 14-1 / 2$ " pieces of BA01Red and (2) 2$1 / 2$ " x 14-1/2" pieces of BA06Gold for Sash-2 and Sash-20.
8. Cut and sew together on the long side (5) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" pieces of BA01Red and (5) 2$1 / 2$ " x 14-1/2" pieces of BA04Green for Sash-3, Sash-7,Sash-14, Sash-18, and Sash-21.
9. Cut and sew together on the long side (3) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" pieces of BA03Blue and (3) 2$1 / 2$ " x 14-1/2" pieces of BA06Gold for Sash-5, Sash-12, and Sash-16.
10. Cut and sew together on the long side (3) $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 14-1 / 2$ " pieces of BA06Gold and (3) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" pieces of BA04Green for Sash-6, Sash-13, and Sash-17.

## Assembling the Sashing and the Blocks together-

1. Place the blocks together in rows referring to the photo in this order and sew together:


C2 - Sash-8 - C1 - Sash-9 - C2 - Sash-10 - C1
Sash-11 - Block 1-C - Sash-12 - Block 1-D - Sash-13 - Block 1-E - Sash-14
C1 - Sash-8 - C2 - Sash-9 - C1 - Sash-10 - C2
Sash-15 - Block 1-F - Sash-16 - Block 2-B - Sash-17 - Block 1-G - Sash-18
C2 - Sash-19 - C1 - Sash-20 - C2 - Sash-21 - C1

Quilt as desired and then bind it with BA08Gold with your favorite method.
