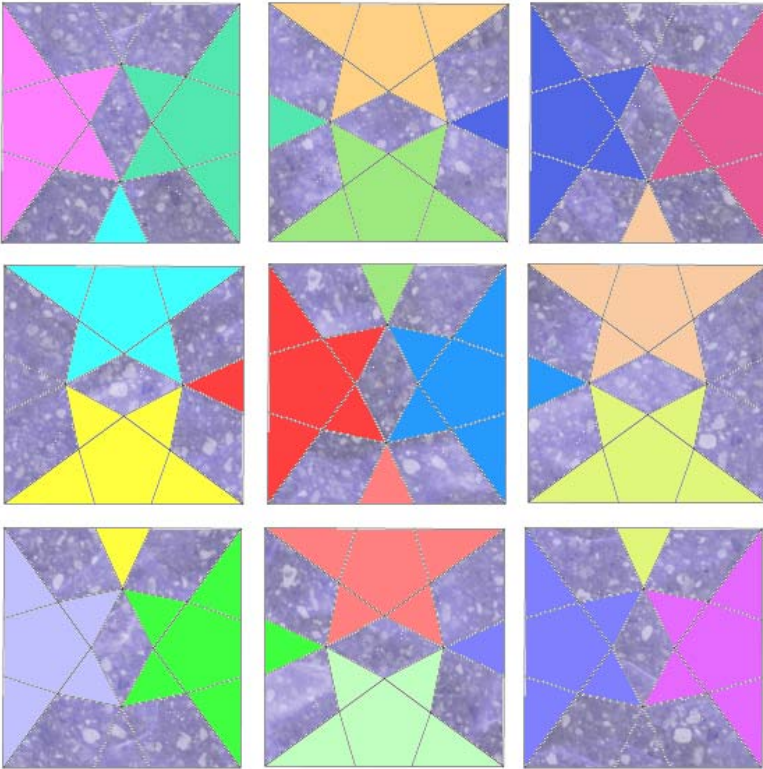


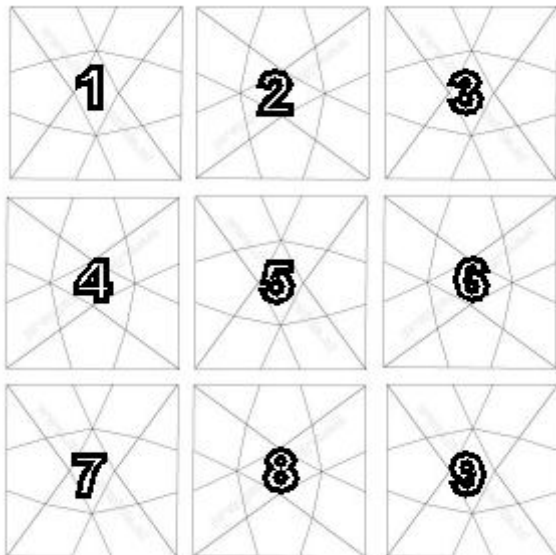
Picture A



In Picture A you see the setting of the blocks. Each block is the same, only the colors are different. Each star has one point in the block next to it.

Block 1:

- The one point of the above (not existing) star, you make of the background color.
- The point of the left star (the magenta star) you have to place into your border. If not, there is a star with a missing point in your quilt.
- The point of the right (blue-green) star is placed in block 2.
- The last star, the turquoise star, has 5 pieces in block 4 and one piece in block 1.



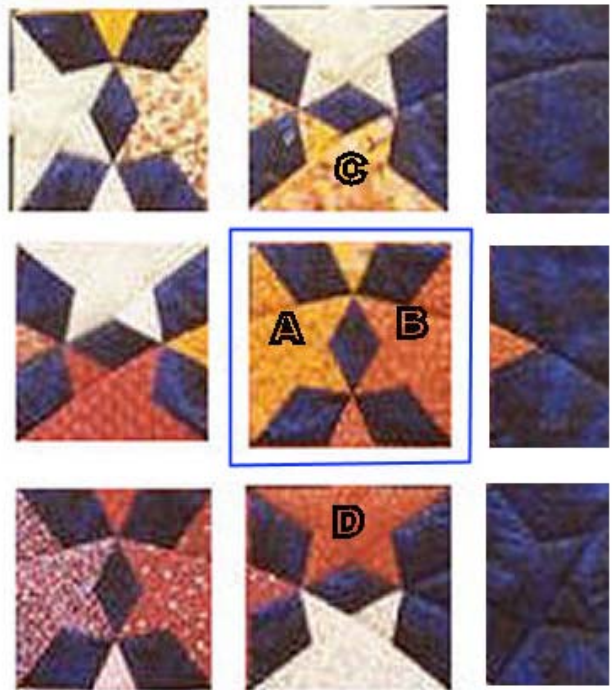
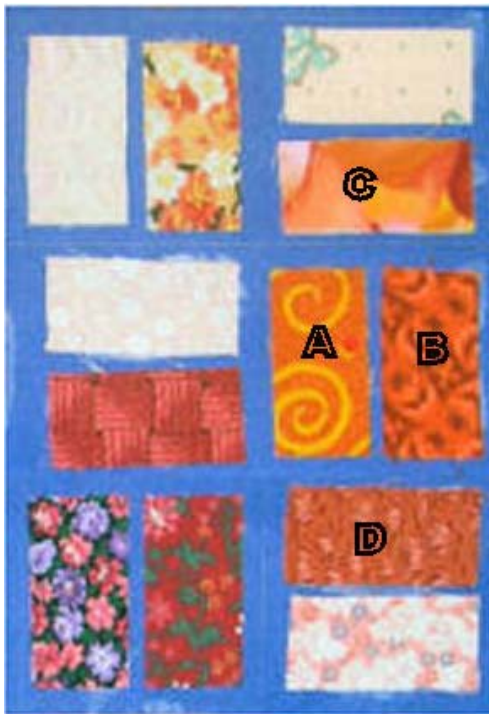


This picture is my own color scheme.

For each star I used a piece of fabric ($\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ") (2x4 cm)

When I liked the setting, I glued all pieces on a piece of paper.

During piecing the blocks I used this as my color guide.



The **color A** on the left picture is corresponding with the color A on the right picture. You can see that in that block the center and four points of the star are in color A. The last point of color A lies in the block at the left.

The **color B** also has the center and four points in the block, the last point is in the border.

The one point of **color C** comes from the block above.

The one point of **color D** comes from the block beneath.

In this way you can decide the placement of the colors in your quilt.
