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Cutting Directions



Fabric #1 Cream/beige/white prints Cut Print 1

- 4 squares 2" x 2"

Print 2

- 4 rectangles 2" x 9 1/2"



Fabric #2 Red Prints Cut Print 1

- 2 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- 4 squares 2" x 2"

Print 2

- 2 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- 4 squares 2" x 2"



Fabric #3 Aqua Prints

Cut Print 1

- 2 squares 4" x 4" for HST **Print 2**
- 1 square 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

My BLOCK Fabric

My blocks are done with a mix of my fabric lines for Moda in Cotton & Batiks plus other moda lines.

Fabric #4 Gray Prints Cut Print 1

- 2 squares 4" x 4" for HST

Block 10

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
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"





Step 1 - Make HST - Using the gray and aqua 4" squares, Make 4 Half Square Triangle (HST) units



Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the light squares



Step 2

- Layer the dark and light square
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to 3.5" x 3.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.

Make 4 HST units

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



Sew and Flip Units



Step 1 Directions

1) Draw a diagonal line on All the 2" red square (8 squares)






Step 2 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a red square on the rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Repeat for the other end.
- 4) Make 4 Measures 2" x 9.5" each

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Step 3 Directions


1) Following the diagram Assemble the center Pinwheel Measures 9.5" x 9.5"

Unit size & Assembly Diagram




Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size 12" in the quilt
