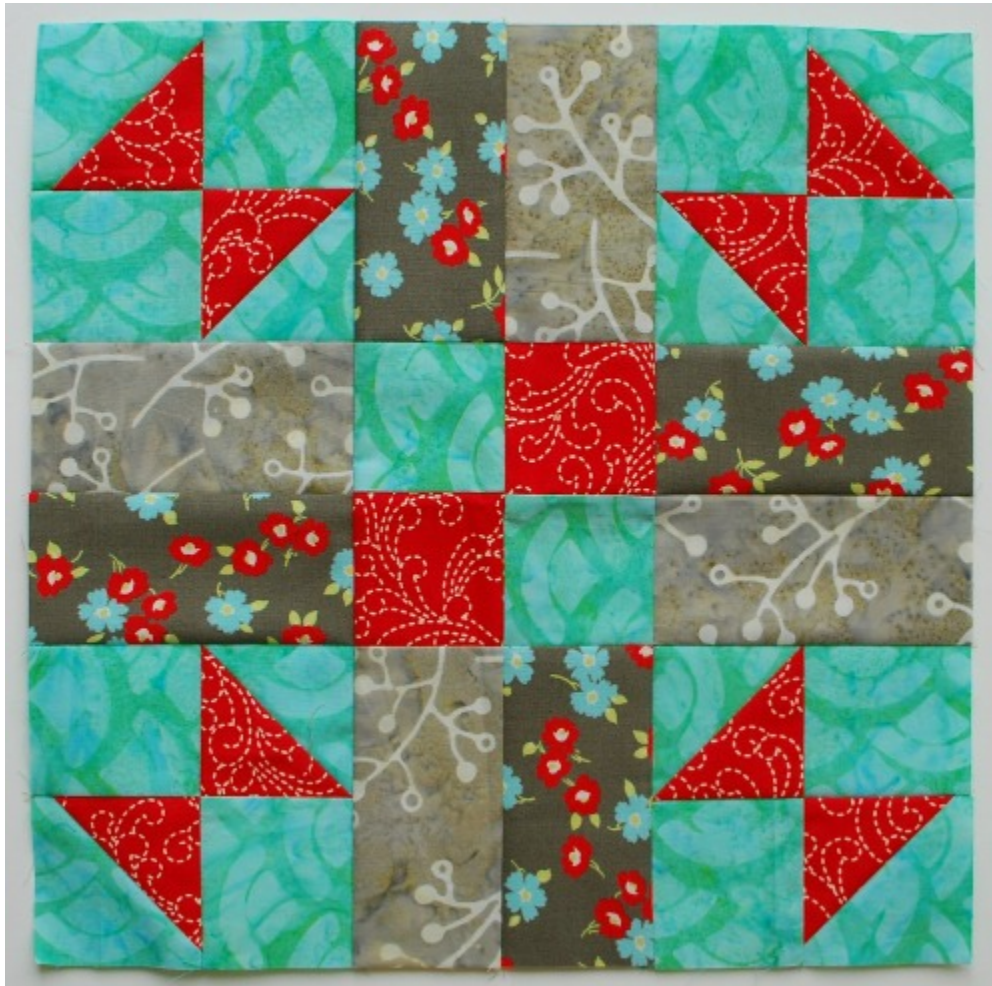

Cutting Directions



Fabric #2 Red Prints

Cut

- 4 squares 3" for HST (half square triangles)
- 2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Fabric #3 Aqua Prints

Cut

- 4 squares 3" for HST (half square triangles)
- 10 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Fabric #4 Gray Prints

Cut

Print 1

- 4 strips 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Print 2

- 4 strips 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

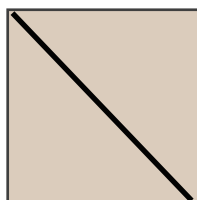

Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"

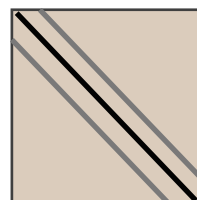


- Using the red and aqua 3" squares,
Make 8 Half Square Triangle
(HST) units



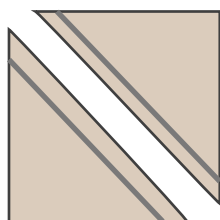
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back
of all the light squares



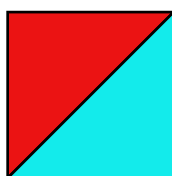
Step 2

- Layer the dark and light square
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both
Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn
Line for 2 HST



Step 4

-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5"
using a square ruler with
a diagonal line placed on the
Seam.

Make 8 HST units

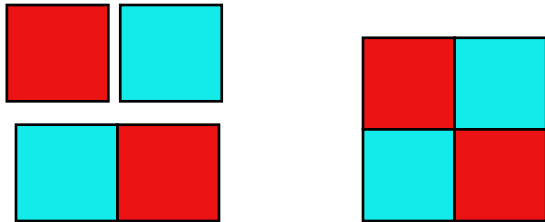

Center 4-Patch



Directions

- 1) Sew the aqua and red squares together
- 2) Sew the top to the bottom unit

Make 1 units that measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Rectangle Units

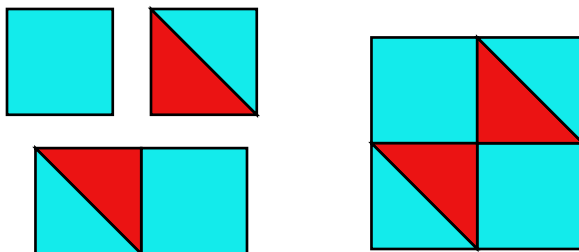


Directions

- 1) Sew the dark and light gray strips together

Make 4 units that measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

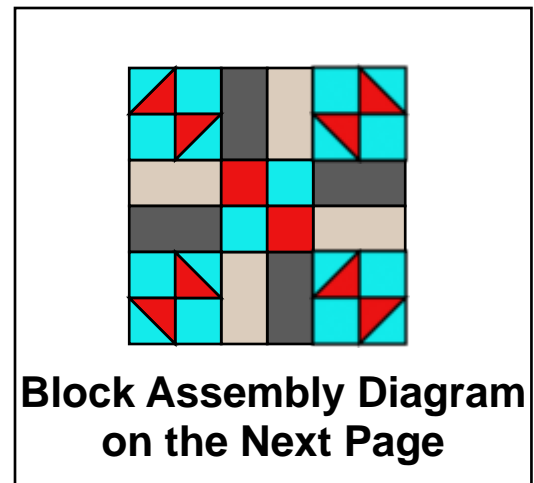
HST Units



Directions

- 1) Alternate the aqua squares and HST units
TIP press towards the SQUARE on Step 1
- 2) Sew the top the bottom unit

Make 4 units that measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

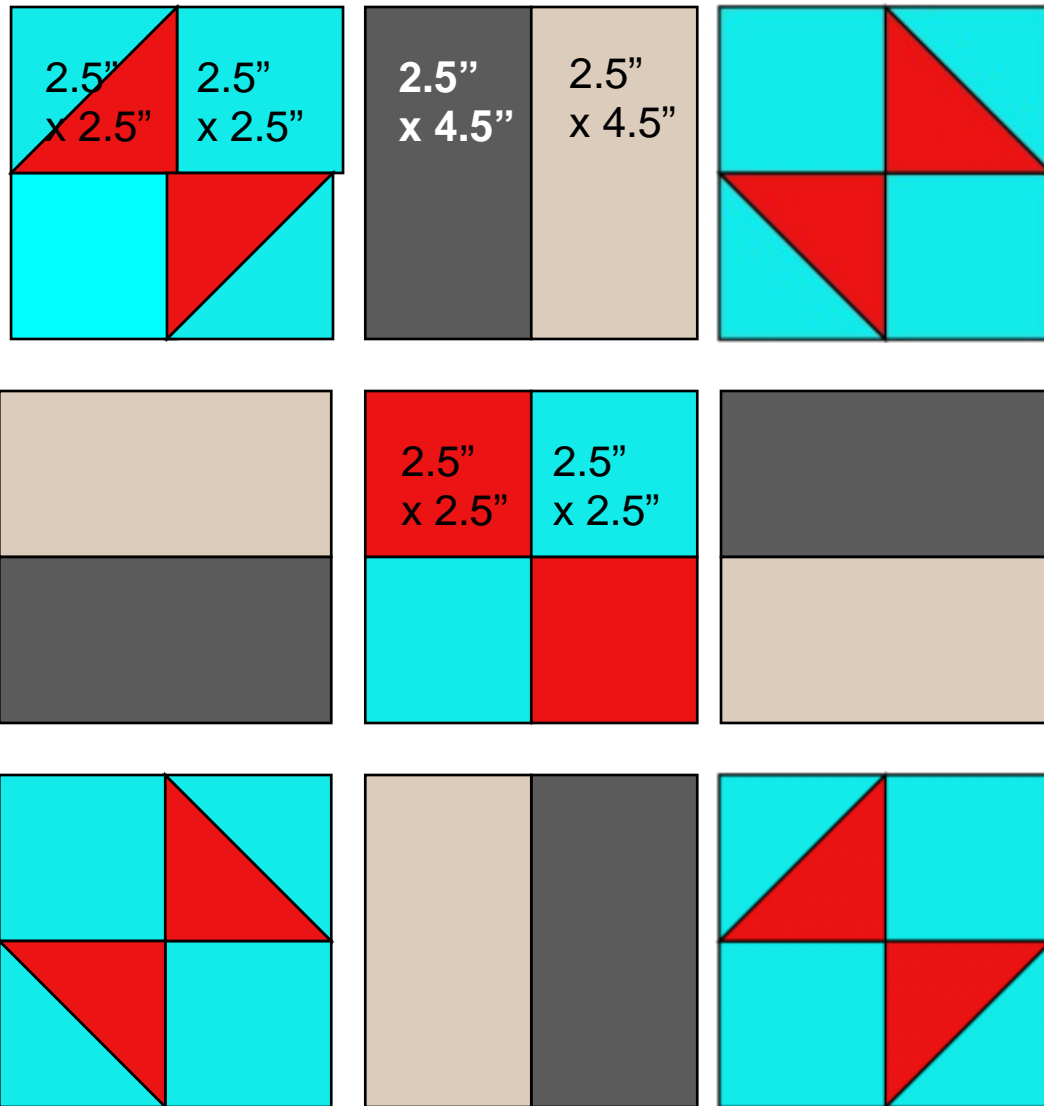

Finished Size 12"

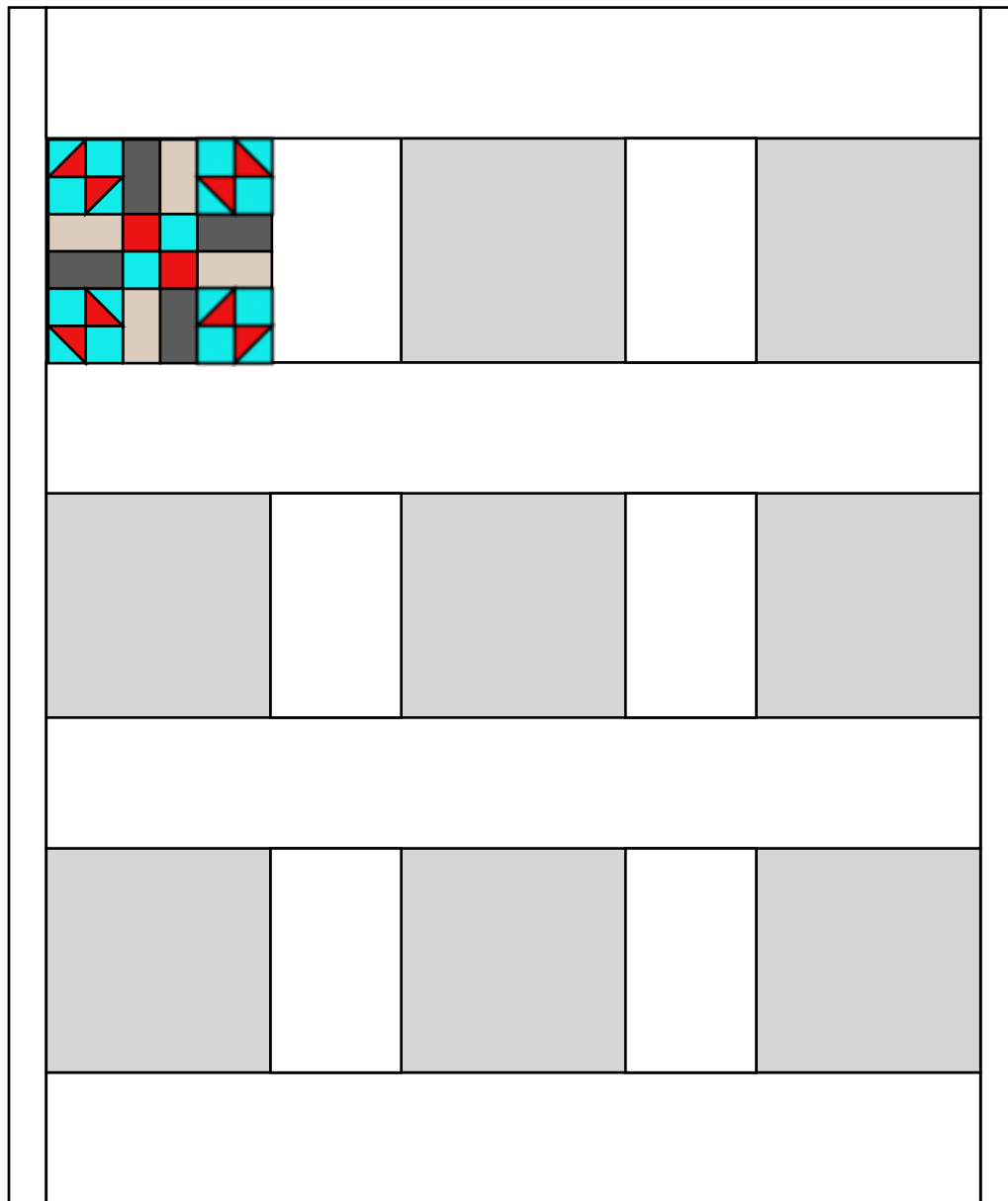
