## Cutting Directions



### Fabric #1 Cream/beige/white prints

#### Cut

##### Print 1

- 1 square 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"



### Fabric #2 Red Prints

#### Cut

##### Print 1

- 4 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

##### Print 2

- 4 rectangles 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"

##### Print 3

- 4 squares 2" x 2"

##### Print 4

- 4 squares 2" x 2"



### Fabric #3 Aqua Prints

#### Cut

##### Print 1

- 4 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

##### Print 2

- 4 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

##### Print 3

- 4 rectangles 2" x 3 1/2"

##### Print 4

- 4 squares 2" x 2"

My blocks are done with my fabric line called 'Sunday Drive' for Moda in Cotton & Batiks PLUS older fabrics of mine and other moda lines ..

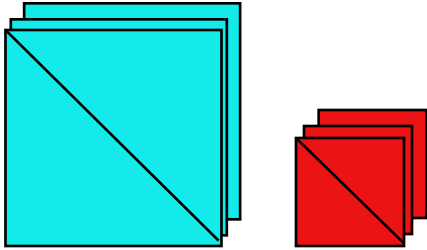

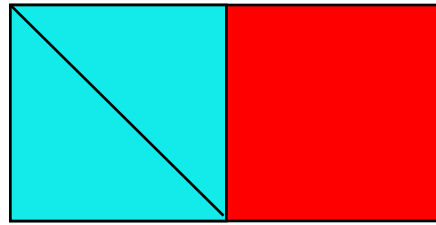

## Flying Geese Tutorial



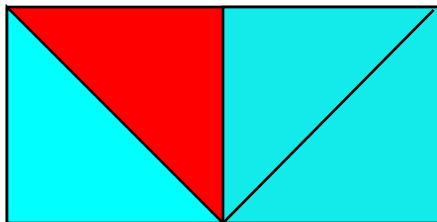
### Step 1 Directions

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on Each 3.5" aqua square and Each 2" red square.
- 2) 8 of each color



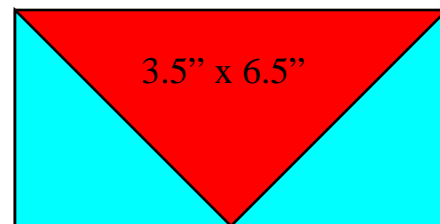
### Step 2 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a aqua square on the red rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4



### Step 3 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 For this square.
- 2) Make 4



Measures 3.5" x 6.5"

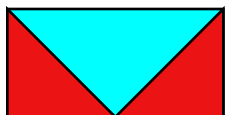

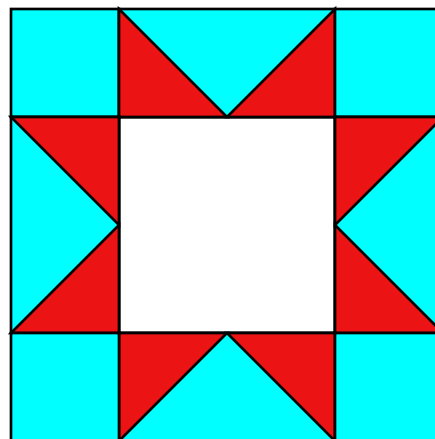
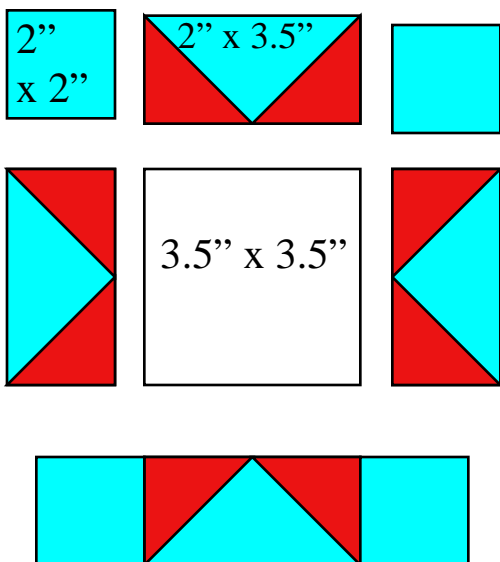

## Step 4 Directions

- 1) Repeat the flying geese directions to  
Make 4 smaller flying geese with the red 2.5" squares  
And the Aqua 2" x 3.5" rectangles
- 2) Make 4. Measure 2" x 3.5"



Measure 6.5" x 6.5"

## Step 5 Directions

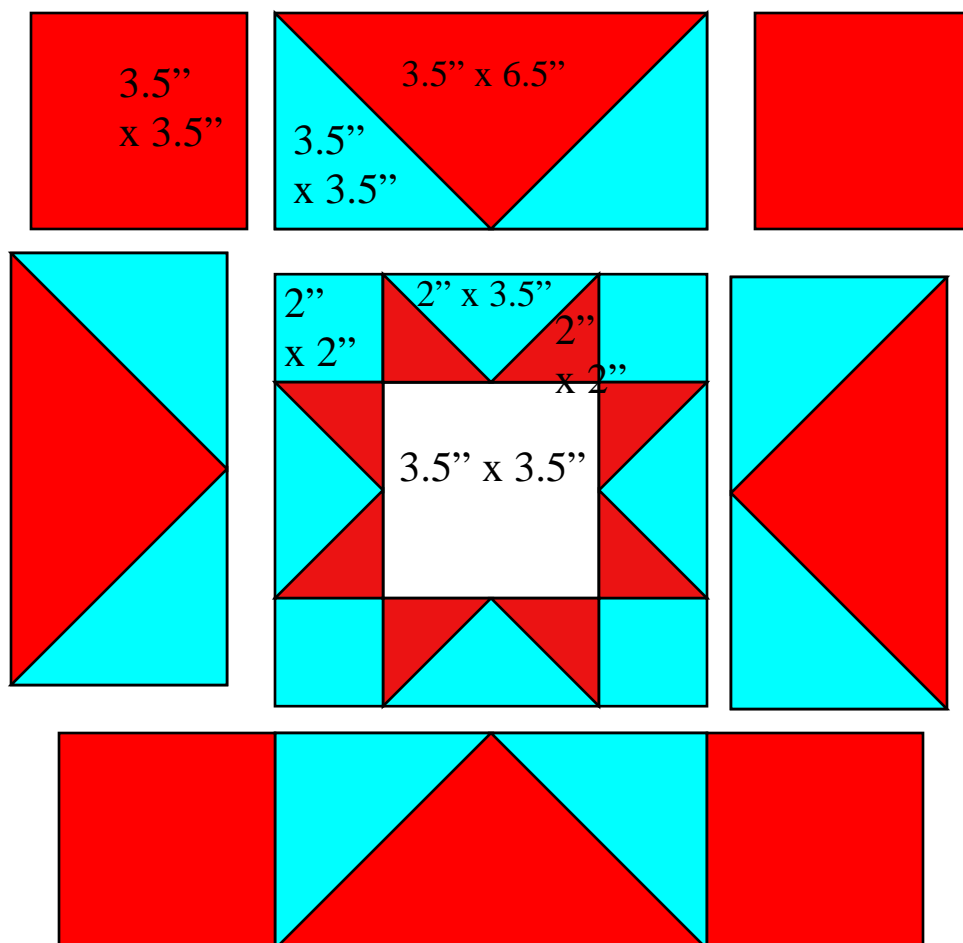
- 1) Following the diagram sew the small star  
NOTE - watch direction of flying geese, red side  
Goes against the center square.
- 2) Make 1. Measure 6.5" x 6.5"

## Assemble



### Step 6 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram sew the final block  
NOTE - watch direction of flying geese, Aqua side  
Goes against the center star
- 2) Make 1.

Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5"  
Finished Size 12" in the quilt
