

### **Cutting Directions**



Fabric #3 Grey Dots

- 2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 2 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"



Fabric #7 Light Green

- 3 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



**Camping Prints** 

- 1 square 7" x 7", cut in half on the Diagonal



#### Fabric #4 Blue Dots

- 8 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- 3 squares 3" x 3", Cut in half on the diagonal





#### Fabric #9 Light Blue

- 8 squares 3" x 3" for HST

#### **BLOCK Fabric**

REMEMBER the blocks are set 'On Point'.

If using Directional fabric decide before cutting how that fabric will look 'On Point'


### Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"





Step 1 - Make HST - Using the blue dot and light blue 3" squares,




Step A

- Draw a line on the back of all the light squares



Step B


- Layer the dark and light square
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step C

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Make 16 Half Square Triangle (HST) units
ONE will not be used



### Step D

-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.



### Large Triangle Unit








#### Step 2 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Sew triangle #1 to a HST lining up the top edge
- 2) Sew Triangle #2
- 3) Make 2 unit A


#### Step 3 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Sew 2 HST
- 2) Sew triangle #1 Lining up the left edge
- 3) Make 2 unit B



#### Step 4 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Sew Unit A to Unit B
- 2) Make 2




#### Step 5 Directions

- 1) Crease the large triangle & HST pieced unit in half to aid in placement
- 2) Line up the crease on both
- 3) Sew the large triangle to the HST unit
- 4) Make 2

Trim unit to 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"
Place the square ruler on the diagonal seam
To trim, just like you do for a HST




#### Step 6 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram sew the green and grey pieces
- 2) Make 1, measures 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"



#### Step 7 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram sew 9 HST units
- 2) Make 1, measures 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"



#### Step 8 Directions


- 1) Following the diagram sew all 4 units for the final block. Notice placement.
- 2) Make 1, measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"






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# Quick View Unit size & Assembly Diagram









3 x 3 cut on diagonal


Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size 12" in the quilt
