# **Cutting Directions**



Fabric #2 Red Dots
- 8 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Fabric #4 Blue Dots
- 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"



Fabric #6 Cream - 8 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Fabric #9 Light Blue
- 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"



**Camping Prints** 


- 16 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"For flying geese- 1 center square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

#### **BLOCK Fabric**

REMEMBER the blocks are set 'On Point'.

If using Directional fabric decide before cutting how that fabric will look 'On Point'




### Flying Geese Units




Step 1 Directions

1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" camping print square Make 16




#### Step 2 Directions

- Following the diagram,
- Place a camping square on the light blue rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 2.5" x 4.5"








#### Step 3 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
- 2) Make 4

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"


#### Step 4 Directions

- 1) Following steps 2 & 3 repeat for the Blue Dot rectangles
- 2) Make 4

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"






#### Step 5 Directions


- 1) Following the diagram sew a blue dots and light blue flying geese block together
- 2) Make 4

measures 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"



#### Step 6 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram sew 2 red dot and 2 cream squares into a 4-patch
- 2) Make 4 measures 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"



#### Step 7 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram sew the block
- 2) Make 1, measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"




### Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"





Step 1 - Make HST - Using the blue dot and light blue 3" squares,




Step A

- Draw a line on the back of all the light squares



Step B


- Layer the dark and light square
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step C

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Make 16 Half Square Triangle (HST) units
ONE will not be used



### Step D

-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
