Cutting Directions



Fabric #2 Red Dots
- 6 squares 3" x 3" for HST



Fabric #3 Gray dots

- 4 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- 6 squares 3" x 3" for HST



Camping Prints Light background

- 1 square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"



Fabric #10 Gold


- 4 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

BLOCK Fabric

REMEMBER the blocks are set 'On Point'.

If using Directional fabric decide before cutting how that fabric will look 'On Point'

2018 Let's Go Camping!

Directions

1) Using the 3" gray 3" red fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page.

Make 12 units - trim to 2 1/2" square



Assemble the corner units


2) Following the diagram sew a 2 1/2" gold square and 3 HST units for the corner Make 4 units

Measures 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"



Assemble the block

3) Following the diagram sew the block Measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"






Block #6 - 'Stirring the Pot'

Half Square Triangles Tutorial



Make HST

- Pair a dark fabric and a Light fabric square




Step A

- Draw a line on the back of all the light squares




Step B

- Layer the dark and light square
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step CCut on the drawn Line for 2 HST



Step D

3" starting squares
Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5"
using a square ruler with
a diagonal line placed on the
Seam.
