## **Cutting Directions**



Fabric #2 Red Dots

- 2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for half square triangles
- 2 squares 4" x 4" for half square triangles



Fabric #7 Light Green

- 4 squares 4" x 4" for half square triangles



Fabric #10 Gold

- 2 squares 4" x 4" for half square triangles

- 1 square 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"



#### **Camping Prints**

- 4 strips 2" x 9 1/2"

- 2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for half square triangles

#### **BLOCK Fabric**

REMEMBER the blocks are set 'On Point'.

If using Directional fabric decide before cutting how that fabric will look 'On Point'

#### Step 1 Directions

1) Using the 2 1/2" camping and 2 1/2" red dot fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 2" square




#### Step 2 Directions


1) Using the 4" green and 4" red dot fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 3.5" square



#### Step 3 Directions

1) Using the 4" green and 4" gold fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 3.5" square





#### Step 4 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram use all the large HST to assemble the center star
- 2) Sew 2 camping strips to the sides of the star block
- 3) Sew the small HST to each end of a camping strip
- 4) Sew the final strips to top and bottom noting direction of red dots.


Make 1, measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size 12" in the quilt



Final Quilt - 65" x 65"






# Half Square Triangles Tutorial Use the fabrics and trim to the sizes indicated on page 3




Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares




Step 2

- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST



Step 4

-Trim squares to size Indicated in the block Pattern using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
