## Fabric \#2 Red Dots

- 2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for half square triangles
- 2 squares 4 " x 4 " for half square triangles



## Fabric \#10 Gold

- 2 squares 4 " x 4 " for half square triangles
- 1 square 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"


## Fabric \#7 Light Green

- 4 squares 4 " x 4 " for half square triangles



## Camping Prints

- 4 strips 2" x 9 1/2"
- 2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for half square triangles

## Step 1 Directions

1) Using the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ camping and $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ red dot fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 2 " square


Step 2 Directions

1) Using the 4" green and $4^{\prime \prime}$ red dot fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 3.5 " square


Step 3 Directions

1) Using the 4" green and 4" gold
fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 3.5 " square


## Step 4 Directions

1) Following the diagram use all the large HST to assemble the center star
2) Sew 2 camping strips to the sides of the star block
3) Sew the small HST to each end of a camping strip
4) Sew the final strips to top and bottom noting direction of red dots.

Make 1, measures $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Half Square Triangles Tutorial Use the fabrics and trim to the sizes indicated on page 3



- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares


Step 4
-Trim squares to size Indicated in the block Pattern
using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
