- 1 square $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$


10 Black Dots

- 8 squares $4.5 " \times 4.5 "$


13 Gray Background

- 4 rectangles $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 4 rectangles $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 12 squares $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$

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## 'DUF DF TH/S WDRL7'

## Directions Flying Geese Units Aqua

1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" Aqua solid square Make 8


Step (2)

1) Following the diagram,

Place a Aqua solid square on 2.5 " $\times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$ gray rectangle
2) Sew on the line.
3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a $1 / 4$ " seam.
3) Make 4 Measures $2.5 " \times 4.5$ "

3) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese Make 4
Measures $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$


4) Following the diagram sew the star using 4.5 " space print, 4 gray squares 2.5 ", the 4 flying geese from above
Make 4
Measures 8.5" x 8.5"


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## Assemble Flying Geese Units black dot

5) Draw a diagonal line on each 4.5" Black dot square Make 8

Step (6)

1) Following the diagram,

Place a Black Dot square on $4.5 " \times 8.5$ " gray rectangle
2) Sew on the line.
3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a $1 / 4$ " seam.
3) Make 4 Measures 4.5 " x $8.5^{\prime \prime}$

7) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese Make 4

Measures 4.5" x 8.5"

9) Using 2 of the 2.5 " plaid squares and 2 of the 2.5 " gray squares make a 4 -patch unit Make 4
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"

9) Following the diagram assemble the block Make 1
Measures $16.5^{\prime \prime} \times 16.5^{\prime \prime}$

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Trim Block to $16.5^{\prime \prime} \times 16.5^{\prime \prime}$
Finished Size 16 " in the quilt

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## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares


Step 2

- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on both

Sides of the drawn line


Step 3
Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

## Step 4


-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
