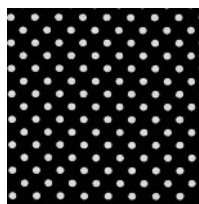
## Cutting Directions



- 6** **Space print**  
- 1 square 4.5" x 4.5"



- 9** **Plaid**  
- 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



- 10** **Black Dots**  
- 8 squares 4.5" x 4.5"



- 12** **Solid Aqua**  
- 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



- 13** **Gray Background**  
- 4 rectangles 4.5" x 8.5"  
- 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"  
- 12 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

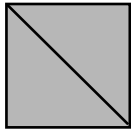

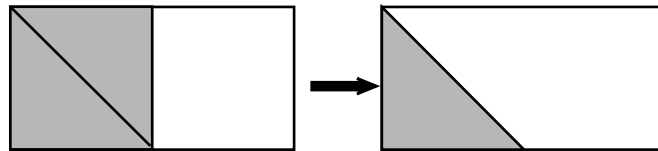
## Directions Flying Geese Units Aqua

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" Aqua solid square  
Make 8

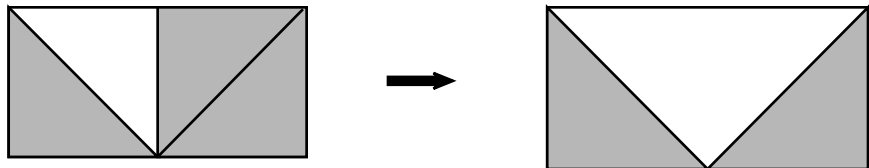


### Step (2)

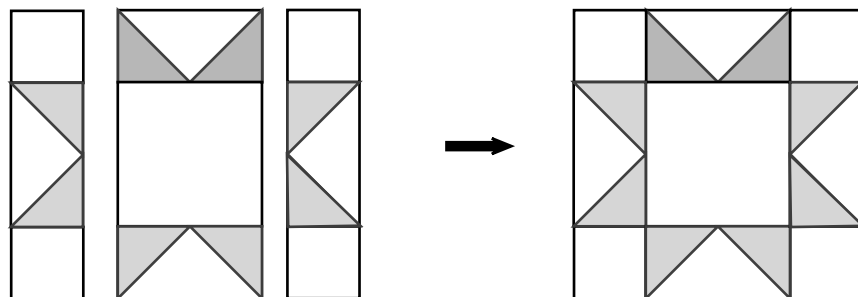
- 1) Following the diagram, Place a Aqua solid square on 2.5" x 4.5" gray rectangle
  - 2) Sew on the line.
  - 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
  - 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



- 3) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese  
Make 4  
Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



- 4) Following the diagram sew the star using 4.5" space print, 4 gray squares 2.5", the 4 flying geese from above  
Make 4  
Measures 8.5" x 8.5"



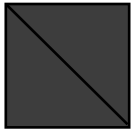

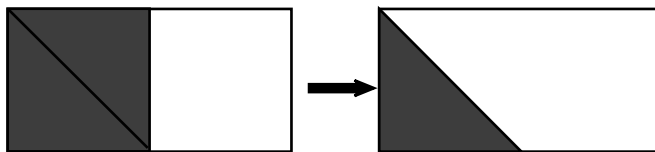
**Assemble Flying Geese Units black dot**

5) Draw a diagonal line on each 4.5" Black dot square  
Make 8



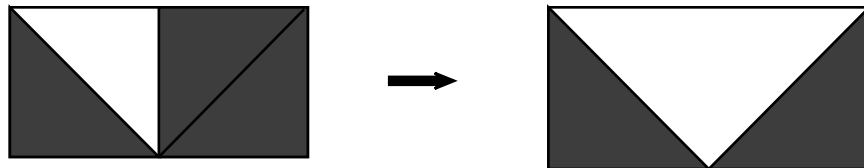
Step (6)

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a Black Dot square on 4.5" x 8.5" gray rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 4.5" x 8.5"



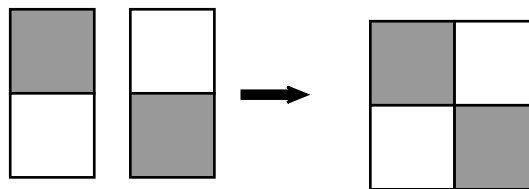
7) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese  
Make 4

Measures 4.5" x 8.5"



9) Using 2 of the 2.5" plaid squares and 2 of the 2.5" gray squares make a 4-patch unit  
Make 4

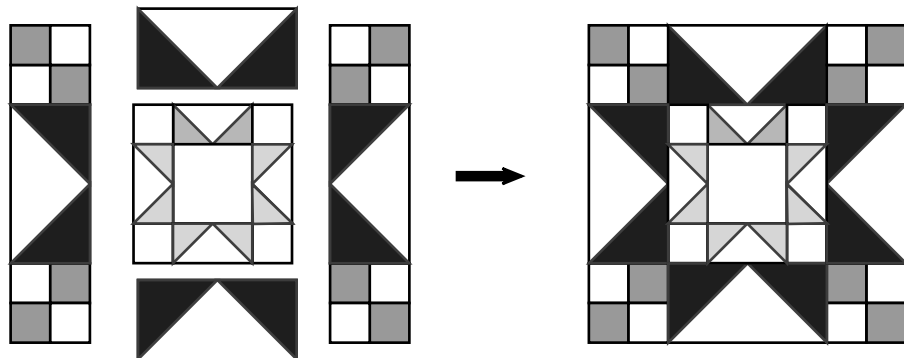
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"



9) Following the diagram assemble the block

Make 1

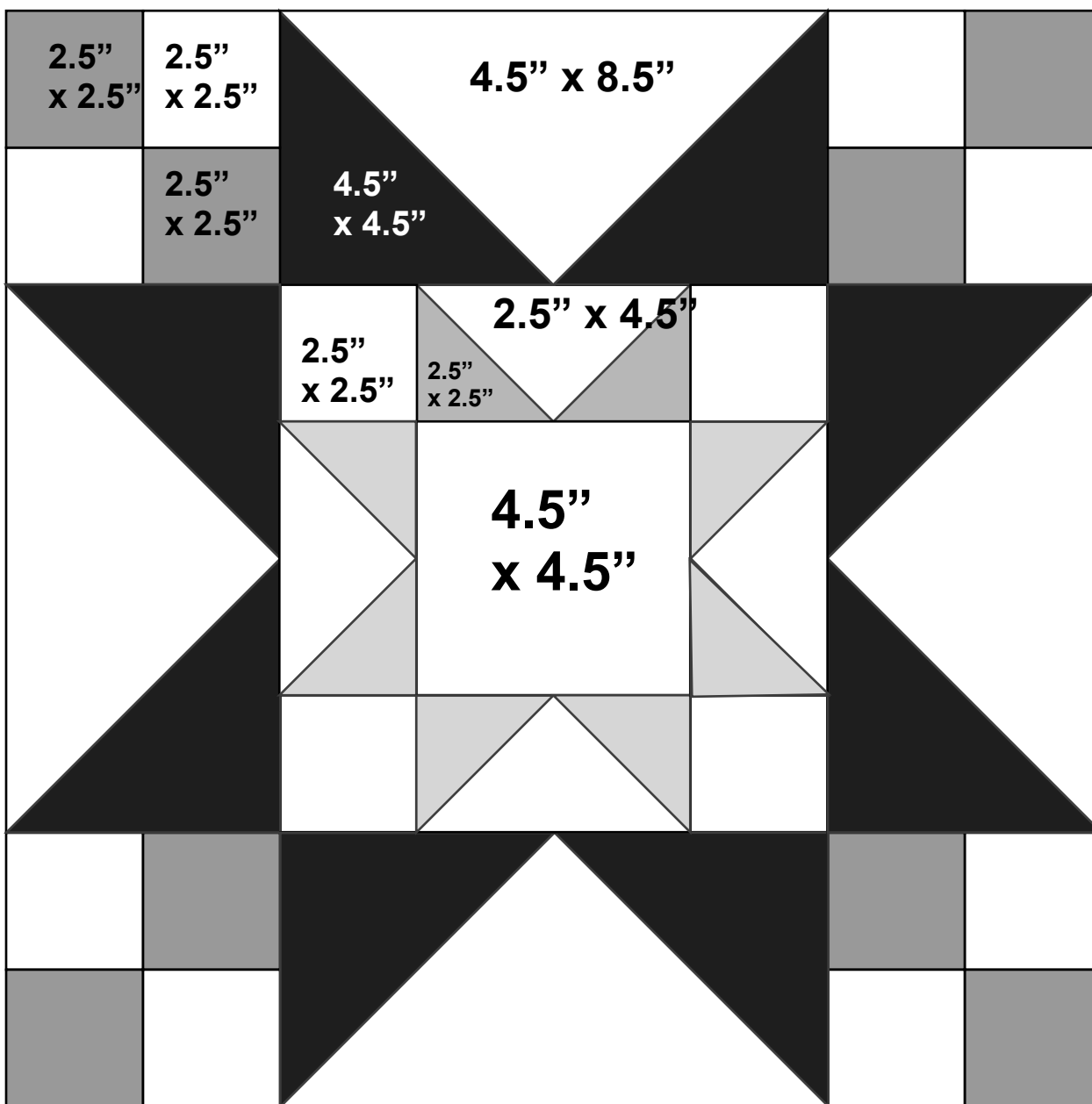
Measures 16.5" x 16.5"

## Block #10 Cut Sizes



Trim Block to 16.5" x 16.5"

Finished Size 16" in the quilt

## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

**NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book  
"Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"**



**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



**Step 2**

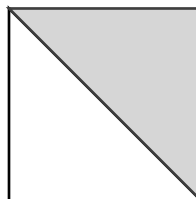
- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

**Step 4**



-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
