Space print

- 1 square $4.5 " \times 4.5 "$

TIP - I fussy cut a motif from the fabric

## Blue Dot

- 4 squares $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 8 squares $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$


9
Plaid

- 12 squares $2.5 " \times 2.5 "$


10 Black Dots

- 8 squares $2.5 " \times 2.5 "$



## 13 Gray Background

- 12 rectangles $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 8 squares 2.5 " 2.5 "

## Directions

Flying Geese Units


Step 1

1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" Blue dot square Make 8


Step 2

1) Following the diagram,

Place a blue dot square on 2.5 " x 4.5 " gray rectangle
2) Sew on the line.
3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam.
3) Make 4 Measures $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$



Step 3

1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
2) Make 4

Measures $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5$ "

## Directions for Sew and Flip units

4) Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" Black dot square
Following diagram place a $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ Black dot square on a 4.5 " x 4.5 " Blue dot square, right sides together. sew ON the line.
Make 4
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"

5) Following diagram place another $2.5 " \times 2.5$ " black dot square on the Blue dot square, right sides together.
Sew ON the line.
Make 4
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"

6) Following diagram trim away

The other side leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance Trim 4
Press triangles open to make a square Measures 4.5" x 4.5"

## Directions for Chain units

8) Following diagram create the 4 corner Units using the plaid squares, the remaining Gray squares and rectangles
Make 4
Measures $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$
TIP - they are identical, turn to place in Each corner when you assemble them

9) Following diagram sew the star block

Make 1
Measures $16.5^{\prime \prime} \times 16.5^{\prime \prime}$


## 'ロUT ロF THIS WORLT' Block \#1 Cut Sizes



Trim Block to $16.5^{\prime \prime} \times 16.5^{\prime \prime}$
Finished Size 16 " in the quilt
