
6 Space print
- 1 square 4.5" x 4.5"
TIP - I fussy cut a
motif from the fabric



8 Blue Dot - 4 squares 4.5" x 4.5" - 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



Plaid12 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



1 D Black Dots

- 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



13 Gray Background

- 12 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"
- 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



#### Flying Geese Units




Step 1

1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" Blue dot square Make 8



#### Step 2


- 1) Following the diagram,
- Place a blue dot square on 2.5" x 4.5" gray rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



Step 3

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
- 2) Make 4

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"






#### **Directions for Sew and Flip units**

- 4) Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" Black dot square Following diagram place a 2.5" x 2.5" Black dot square on a 4.5" x 4.5" Blue dot square, right sides together. sew ON the line. Make 4 Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
- 5) Following diagram trim away Leaving a 1/4" seam allowance Trim all 4 Measures 4.5" x 4.5"







- 6) Following diagram place another 2.5" x 2.5" black dot square on the Blue dot square, right sides together. Sew ON the line.

  Make 4

  Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
- 7) Following diagram trim away
  The other side leaving a 1/4" seam allowance
  Trim 4
  Press triangles open to make a square
  Measures 4.5" x 4.5"


#### **Directions for Chain units**

8) Following diagram create the 4 corner Units using the plaid squares, the remaining Gray squares and rectangles


Make 4

Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

**TIP** - they are identical, turn to place in Each corner when you assemble them



9) Following diagram sew the star block Make 1 Measures 16.5" x 16.5"
