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Cutting Directions



Gray Space print
- 1 square 4.5" x 4.5"
TIP - I fussy cut a
motif from the fabric



Half moon
- 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"



4 Blue lines
- 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



14 Constellations
- 2 squares 5" x 5" for HST



13 Gray Background
- 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"
- 2 squares 5" x 5" for HST



Flying Geese Units




Step 1

1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" Blue line square Make 8



Step 2


- 1) Following the diagram,
- Place a blue line square on 2.5" x 4.5" gray rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



Step 3

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
- 2) Make 4

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"

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


Assemble

4) Following the diagram sew the Flying geese unit to the top of the Half moon rectangle.


Make 4

Measures 4.5" x 4.5"




5) Using the 5" squares make HSTs using the method on last page.

Make 4 units trim to 4.5" square



6) Following the diagram sew the block Make 1, measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"


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Block #2 Cut Sizes





Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size 12" in the quilt

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




Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
