Gray Space print - 1 square $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5$ " TIP - I fussy cut a motif from the fabric


3
Half moon
4 rectangles $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$


4 Blue lines

- 8 squares $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$

## Directions

Flying Geese Units


Step 1

1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" Blue line square Make 8


Step 2

1) Following the diagram,

Place a blue line square on 2.5 " x 4.5 " gray rectangle
2) Sew on the line.
3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a $1 / 4$ " seam.
3) Make 4 Measures 2.5 " $\times 4.5$ "



Step 3

1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
2) Make 4

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"

4) Following the diagram sew the Flying geese unit to the top of the Half moon rectangle.
Make 4
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"

5) Using the 5" squares make HSTs using the method on last page.
Make 4 units
trim to 4.5" square

6) Following the diagram sew the block Make 1, measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares


Step 2

- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on both

Sides of the drawn line


Step 3
Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

## Step 4


-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
