## Cutting Directions



4 Blue lines
-16 squares 3 " $\times 3$ "


10
Black Polka dot

- 4 strips 2.5" $21^{\prime \prime}$

5 Aqua stars

- 4 squares $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$


11 gold

- 8 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ for HST
-4 squares 2.5 " 2.5 "


## 13 Gray Background

-4 strips $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$
-8 rectangles $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5$
-8 rectangles $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$
-8 rectangles $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$

- 12 squares 4.5 " $\times 4.5$ "
- 8 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ for HST
- 12 squares 2.5 " $\times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$

## Directions

Step 1

1) Flowing the directions on the last page for HST use 2 gray and 2 gold 3 " squares.


Trim to 2.5 " square
Make 16

## Step 2

1) Following the diagram, sew the gray and black polka dot strips together

2) Cut into 2.5 " wide subunits

Measures $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$
Cut 8 units
Repeat with the other 3 strips
3) Sew 2 pairs of 2-patch units from above together Measures $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$
Make 16 total 4-patch units


## Step 3

1) Following the diagram Place the light blue stripe 3 " square on the aqua 4.5 " square, right sides together Sew ON the line. Make 1

2) Following the diagram place another Blue stripe square on the aqua square, right sides together Sew ON the line. Make 1

3) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
Trim off both ends
Press triangles open to make a square Measure 4.5" x 4.5"


NOTE: this is a floating center square, it does not touch the edge when sewn into the block

## Assemble

4) Following the diagram Place the light blue stripe 3" square on the aqua square, right sides together Sew ON the line. Make 1
5) Following the diagram place another Blue stripe square on the aqua square, right sides together Sew ON the line.
Make 1

6) Following the diagram trim away leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Trim off both ends
Press triangles open to make a square Measure 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 1

7) The center square will float. The point is not at the top of the block.
Measure 4.5" x 4.5"
Repeat to Make 4

## Step 4

1) Following the diagram Sew the block into units

Next page is the block fully assembled
Measures 16.5" x 16.5 "
Make 4

Block \#3 Cut Sizes


Trim Block to $16.5^{\prime \prime} \times 16.5^{\prime \prime}$
Finished Size 16 " in the quilt

## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares


Step 2

- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on both

Sides of the drawn line


Step 3
Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

## Step 4


-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
