
Cutting Directions



4 Blue lines
-16 squares 3" x 3"



5 Aqua stars - 4 squares 4.5" x 4.5"



1 O Black Polka dot - 4 strips 2.5" x 21"



1 1 Gold- 8 squares 3" x 3" for HST- 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

13 Gray Background

- 4 strips 2.5" x 21"
- 8 rectangles 4.5" x 6.5"
- 8 rectangles 2.5" x 8.5"
- 8 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"
- 12 squares 4.5" x 4.5"
- 8 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- 12 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Directions


Step 1

Flowing the directions on the last page for HST use 2 gray and 2 gold 3" squares. Trim to 2.5" square Make 16




Step 2


- Following the diagram, sew the gray and black polka 1) dot strips together
- Cut into 2.5" wide subunits Measures 2.5" x 4.5" Cut 8 units Repeat with the other 3 strips
- Sew 2 pairs of 2-patch units from above together Measures 4.5" x 4.5" Make 16 total 4-patch units




Step 3


Following the diagram Place the light blue stripe 3" square on the aqua 4.5" square, right sides together Sew ON the line. Make 1





Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Trim off both ends Press triangles open to make a square Measure 4.5" x 4.5"







NOTE: this is a floating center square, it does not touch the edge when sewn into the block





Assemble

- 4) Following the diagram Place the light blue stripe 3" square on the aqua square, right sides together Sew ON the line.


 Make 1
- 5) Following the diagram place another Blue stripe square on the aqua square, right sides together Sew ON the line.






6) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Trim off both ends
Press triangles open to make a square Measure 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 1





7) The center square will float. The point is not at the top of the block.
Measure 4.5" x 4.5"
Repeat to Make 4



1) Following the diagram Sew the block into units Next page is the block fully assembled Measures 16.5" x 16.5" Make 4




Half Square Triangles Tutorial


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
