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Cutting Directions




Full moon
- 1 square 4.5" x 4.5"
TIP - I fussy cut a
motif from the fabric



5 Aqua Sky

- 2 squares 5" x 5" for HST



10 Black Polka dots

- 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

- 12 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



12 Aqua

- 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"



13 Gray Background

- 2 squares 5" x 5" for HST

- 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

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

Flying Geese Units




Step 1

- Draw a diagonal line on each grey and each black polka dot 2.5" squares.
- ** 4 of the black polka dot squares Are for the next block Make 16




Step 2

- Following the diagram, 1) Place a polka dot square on 2.5" x 4.5" aqua rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- Make 4 Measures 2.5" x 4.5" 3)








Step 3

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
- 2) Make 4

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"

Step 4

Repeat for the 1) Gray squares and Black polka dot rectangles Measures 2.5" x 4.5" Make 4


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

Make 4 units trim to 4.5" square




6) Following the diagram sew the Place a 2.5" black polka dot square On the aqua sky corner Sew on the line Trim, flip the corner over Make 4 Measures 4.5" x 4.5"



7) Following the diagram sew the flying geese units together



8) Following the diagram sew the block ... TIP - carefully place each flying geese To make the image.

measures 12.5" x 12.5"



Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size 12" in the quilt

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


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


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
