Cutting Directions



Plants

- 1 square 4.5" x 4.5" TIP - cut to show a selection of the fabric that you like



Blue Dots

- 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"
- 16 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



Constellations

- 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



13 Gray Background

- 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"
- 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST


Directions

Flying Geese Units



Step 1

1) Draw a diagonal line on 8 Of the 2.5" Blue dot squares Make 8




Step 2

1) Following the diagram,

Place a blue dot square on a 2.5" x 4.5" gray rectangle

- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



Step 3

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
- 2) Make 4

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"

Step 4

- 1) Repeat steps 1 to 3 using 2.5" Constellations squares and the blue dot rectangles
- 2) Make 4

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



Block 5




Assemble

5) Following the diagram sew the Gray Flying geese unit to the top of the blue dot flying geese unit.

Make 4

Measures 4.5" x 4.5"




6) Using the 3" squares make HSTs using the method on last page. Make 8 units

Measures 2.5" x 2.5"




7) Using the 2.5" blue dot squares and the HSTs to make 4patch units Make 4 units

Measures 4.5" x 4.5"



8) Following the diagram sew the block Make 1, measures 12.5" x 12.5"



Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size 12" in the quilt




Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"




Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
