## Cutting Directions

## 7 Plants

- 1 square 4.5 " $\times 4.5$ "

TIP - cut to show a selection of the fabric that you like



- 4 rectangles $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 16 squares $2.5 " \times 2.5$ "

$14^{\text {Constellations }}$
- 4 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ for HST
- 8 squares 2.5 " x $2.5^{\prime \prime}$



## 13 Gray Background

- 4 rectangles 2.5 " x $4.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 4 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ for HST

## Directions

Flying Geese Units


Step 1

1) Draw a diagonal line on 8

Of the 2.5" Blue dot squares Make 8


Step 2

1) Following the diagram,

Place a blue dot square on a 2.5 " $\times 4.5$ " gray rectangle
2) Sew on the line.
3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam.
3) Make 4 Measures $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$


Step 3

1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
2) Make 4

Measures $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5$ "

Step 4

1) Repeat steps 1 to 3 using 2.5" Constellations squares and the blue dot rectangles
2) Make 4

Measures $2.5 " \times 4.5$ "


## Block 5

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## 'ロUT ロF THIS WORLD'

## Assemble

5) Following the diagram sew the Gray Flying geese unit to the top of the blue dot flying geese unit.
Make 4
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"

6) Using the 3 " squares make HSTs using the method on last page. Make 8 units
Measures $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$

7) Using the 2.5 " blue dot squares and the HSTs to make 4 patch units Make 4 units
Measures $4.5^{\prime \prime}$ x 4.5"

8) Following the diagram sew the block

Make 1,
measures $12.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$


## Block 5

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## '0UT DF THIS WORLD'

Block \#5 Cut Sizes


Trim Block to $12.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$
Finished Size 12 " in the quilt

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## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares


Step 2

- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on both

Sides of the drawn line


Step 3
Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

## Step 4


-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
