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### **Cutting Directions**



5 Aqua Sky

- 8 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5" for HST



8 Blue Dot

- 4 strips 2" x 3.5"



1 \( \text{Constellations} \)

- 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5" for HST



13 Gray Background

- 4 rectangles 3.5" x 6.5"
- 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"


#### **Directions**

#### Flying Geese Units




Step 1

1) Draw a diagonal line on each 3.5" Aqua sky squares Make 8



#### Step 2


- 1) Following the diagram,
- Place a Aqua sky square on 3.5" x 6.5" gray rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 3.5" x 6.5"



Step 3

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
- 2) Make 4

Measures 3.5" x 6.5"


#### **Assemble**

4) Using the 2.5" Aqua sky and Constellations squares make HSTs using the method on last page. Make 8 units trim to 2" square




5) Following the diagram sew the block Make 1,

measures 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"



6) Following the diagram sew the block Make 1,


measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size 12" in the quilt




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
#### **Half Square Triangles Tutorial**


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
