10 Black Dot print

- 2 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



11 Gold print

- 8 squares 3" x 3" for HST

- 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



12 Solid Aqua

- 8 squares 3" x 3" for HST



13 Gray Background

- 8 rectangles 2" x 6.5"

- 16 squares 3" x 3" for HST

- 16 squares 2.5" x 2.5"






Directions


1) Using the 3" squares make HSTs using the method on last page.

Make 16 units with the Gold print and Gray background squares Make 16 units with the Aqua solid and Gray background squares trim to 2.5" square




2) Following the diagram sew the Gold HST, the gold squares and the gray background square to make a Friendship star.

Make 4 star blocks Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



3) Following the diagram sew the Aqua HST and the black dot squares to make a Pinwheel block

Make 2 blocks Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



4) Following the diagram sew 2 stars, 1 pinwheel and 4 strips together Make 2 Measures 24.5" x 6.5"




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
Half Square Triangles Tutorial


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
