Buenos-Aires

## 17 Border

-3 squares $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$

## Directions

1) Following the diagram on the last page, use 3 " Buenos-Aires and the 3 " matchmade Blue squares to make 24 HST
Trim to $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
Make 24

2) Following the diagram sew 4 HST together Make 6
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"

3) Following the diagram sew 2 units from step \#2 together Make 2
Measures $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$

4) Following the diagram piece the final block using the 4.5 " squares and units above Make 1
Measures $12.5 " \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$

## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares


Step 2

- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on both

Sides of the drawn line


Step 3
Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

## Step 4


-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
