## String of Diamonds Runner



Finished size: 9" x 54 "


The diamonds in this simple skinny runner showcase large or medium sized prints.

The diamond in a square units are 6 " square finished and are attractively framed by 1-1/2" sashing.

Note: If the runner is finished with a bound edge the runner's finished dimensions will be $9.5^{\prime \prime} \times 54.5^{\prime \prime}$.

## Assembly



## Diamond in a square unit (Make 7)

Sew 2 B triangles to opposite sides of an A square.
Sew 2 more $B$ triangles to remaining sides of the A square.


Sew one $C$ rectangle to each side of diamond in a square unit To make Unit 1.
Repeat for 6 remaining diamond in a square units.


Sew one D square to each end of a C rectangle to make Unit 2.
Repeat for 7 remaining $C$ pieces.

Sew Units 2 to Units 1 as shown below.


Piece fabric to make a $9.5^{\prime \prime} \times 54.5^{\prime \prime}$ backing. Layer a $9.5^{\prime \prime} \times 54.5^{\prime \prime}$ piece of batting, then the backing, right side up. Layer the top right side down on the backing. Sew around all the sides, leaving a 4" opening to turn the runner right side out. Turn right side out and hand stich the opening closed. Quilt runner as desired.
